

Directions from Macon to the 4 Locations of the Trail

DIRECTIONS TO:

Ocmulgee National Monument part of National Park Service

- Going East on I-16 take exit 2 turn left going North onto Coliseum Dr.
- Turn right onto Emery Hwy. Go about 1 mile.
- The park entrance is on your right.

Ocmulgee Heritage Trail operated by New Town Macon

Parking Lot at Spring Street:

- Start going East on I-16.
- Take Exit 1A. Turn right at the bottom of the ramp going South onto Spring St.
- Take the first left after the Interstate overpass and there is the entrance to the parking lot.

Amerson River Park parking lot

- Start going North on I-75.
- Take exit 167. Turn right going East onto North Pierce Ave.
- Stay straight and cross the railroad tracks and you will see the park in front of you.

Brown's Mount operated by Piedmont Wildlife Refuge/Bond Swamp part of U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service

- Start going East on I-16.
- Take exit 6. Turn right going East onto HWY 23/Ocmulgee East Blvd.
- Go 1.3 miles turn right onto Bondsvie Rd., then left onto Joe Brown Rd.
- Follow the sign to Brown's Mount Environmental Education Center

Hitchiti Trail operated by Oconee National Forest part of U.S. Forest Service

- From Macon going North on I-75 take exit 171. Turn right onto Riverside Dr./US23.
- Follow Northeast US 23 north for 7.5 miles.
- Turn right onto GA-18. Go 2.7 miles.
- Turn left onto Jarrell Plantation Rd., going northwest for about 2.5 miles.
- Turn right onto Hitchiti Trail entrance parking lot. There will be brown signs for the trail.
